In February, 2002 the F.I.TAE it is recognized officially by the I.T.F, as the first organization in Spain, under the presidency of MASTER Choi Jung Hwa 8th Degree.

March 2002 he registered “F.I.T.E” Federacion Internacional de TaeKwon-Do España with an official number as a Federation.

May 2002 he gives an Umpire course in Tenerife.
